OBSTACLE COURSE

Gather your kids and join us in the Invention Dimension! Julius Jr.'s Inventing Time activities give you simple ways to play with your kids that encourage their natural creativity!

Get outside to build and play on your own personal obstacle course together!

Objects Needed to Create Your Invention:

- An inside or outside space where your child can have some freedom to move around freely
- Inside options: painter's tape, small chairs and tables, yoga mats or carpet squares, naturally occurring obstacles like stairs, a beach ball, rolling toys, pillows or sleeping bags
- Outside options: a safe playground, a hiking trail or park area with naturally occurring obstacles such as sticks, holes, curbs, tree branches, low walls, rocks, streams, boulders



Step Inside the Box with Julius Jr.! Ask Your Kids:

- Have you ever played on an obstacle course? What kinds of challenges did it have?
- Let's build an obstacle course together, and take turns going through it. What can we use to build challenges as we go through our course?
- What sections are too hard for us? Too easy?
- What is the most fun?
- Do you want to make up a story to go with the course? You can pretend that you are an adventurer on an important mission. What are you searching for? What are the dangers you face?
